

A breach of this rule <u>shall be considered</u> sufficient to result in immediate dismissal.

I hope the officials will take into consideration the great savings that would be made to the budget.

The councillors have not <u>taken into consideration</u> the requests submitted by the residents.

These are the facts which will be taken into consideration at the meeting to be held at the end of the week.

The rules state that everything on the agenda <u>shall</u> <u>be taken into consideration</u> by the Board at the meeting.
