

It was a lovely day and I was happy to be on my way to the bay. Along the route, I saw many farms full of sheep and cows.


I saw meadows of hay ready for the autumn mowing and baling. It was my aim to arrive at eight so I had all day to enjoy myself.






The Japanese city of Tokyo has nice views for the visitor too. In July I will visit Niagara Falls with my family.




